## School Supplies List – September 2019

Over the summer break, you may be out shopping for the materials that your child will need for the next school year. Please refer to the list below to get you started. Individual teachers will send out a more detailed list in September:

- duo tangs (different colours, approximately 5)
- pencils (average of 3 pencils per month, 30 pencils for the year)
- wax crayons (FDK), pencil crayons (Gr. 1-6)
- markers (washable)
- calculator
- erasers (10 for the school year)
- Geometry set (Gr. 5 and 6)
- pencil sharpener (with container for shavings)
- three ring lined paper (Gr. 4 and up)
- pencil case for carrying all supplies
- ruler (at least 5 for the year; they get broken/lost)
- scissors
- glue sticks and/or glue bottle
- box of facial tissue for desk
